





Chairman's Message

According to World Bank, 65 M of Pakistanis live below the poverty line and another 65 M are in lower income bracket. The government, Private sector and the civil society are all trying to develop various programs to address this, learning from other countries who has done a good job at that. I wish to highlight two significant aspects of how it works:

- 1. The immediate objective is to create opportunities for new and more highly paying jobs for a large portion of our population. This will increase their earning power to such an extent that they can live a respectable life (food, shelter & health) and also become future buyers of products made by our industry, thereby generating an upward spiral of economic growth and prosperity.
- 2. To create jobs, the governments and the private sector invests in infrastructure and industrial projects all of which needs professionals like engineers, doctors, business managers and agricultural & IT specialists

The mission of Professional Education Foundation (PEF) is to uplift thousands of families from poverty to prosperity. These are brilliant students, who have obtained an admission in a highly competitive professional institution but come from such families who cannot afford to pay their fees. Upon graduation they will be step in a world of success where sky is the limit, thereby contributing to the upward spiral of economic growth.

Secondly, all investment & social projects like establishing industries, building roads & hospitals etc need professionals, which is the valuable output of PEF.

I would like to highlight a few unique features about PEF

- 1. It offers the most concrete and fastest return to society on your investment. Upon graduation and their first employment, these students will earn back all the money spent on their education within 8 months.
- 2. If you listen to success stories of our students, your investment has enabled them to take care of not only their immediate families but also fund education of their siblings and relatives

- 3. Our zakat compliant process not only meets the requirement of Zakat but also captures the concept of Sadqa e Jariya. Through your Zakat contribution, you have planted a tree which will give fruit for the rest of its life.
- 4. We work with 37 professional universities across country including some of the top-ranking universities in Pakistan. Our student selection criteria is transparent and we don't discriminate on any basis

Where else would you find a better and such a measurable return on investment to society on your donations?

Starting with 75 students in 2009, we have grown and educated 1825 students in 2018-19.

Our target for 2019-20 was to educate 2000 students, but due to the extraordinary situation created by Corona virus, we might not be able achieve this. However we do plan to grow to 3000 by 2025. By the end of this fiscal year about 1325 students would have graduated and have gone on to the job market, being gainfully employed in the economic activity and taking care of their families.

We pay special attention to our management process, which include all payments being made directly to universities and keeping our donors informed about the progress of their students.

We are certified by the Pakistan Centre of Philanthropy (PCP) and I-Care Pakistan awarded us a prize for "distinguished services to humanity" based on our most innovative business model.

All this has been possible because of your generous and continuous support, for which I and our Board of Governors are deeply grateful to you.

I am thankful to the Board of Governors for taking an active part in fund-raising and in the management of PEF. I am also thankful to the PEF staff who have worked tirelessly in achieving these results over the years.





During his academic career Irfan had high grades due to which he got admission in Dow Medical College. PEF funded his annual education fees till his graduation. Later, despite the challenges he faced, he was able to come to USA and complete his certification. After being employed, he started earning a decent salary and took full financial responsibility of his parents and siblings' educational cost. He has also committed to sponsor two students of PEF every year. Dr. Irfan's message is, "I was able to become a doctor, today I am on the team of doctors fighting Corona virus and trying to save lives.

The world has experienced Covid Pandemic in which it has become very clear that a strong medical community is essential in the well being of Pakistan. This pandemic also highlighted a fact that Pakistan is in a dire need of good doctors and medical personal who should be well trained to face any kind of national or global emergencies.

Keeping this in mind PEF's role of producing good, competent doctors have become even more pronounced. I would encourage everyone to join this movement of poverty alleviation through professional education and give opportunities to more students who are just like me".

Working Day And Night Treating Patients




Kainat always wanted to be a doctor but her parents could not financially support her due to low income. Her father was a retired sub-engineer and had three more children to support. Despite all the adversities, her father wanted all his children to succeed in life.

His eldest child, Kainat knew that if she wanted to see a change in their circumstances it would only be through education. She studied day and night and got excellent results in her board exams.

With her siblings studying, there was no way that her parents would have been able to support her dream of pursuing MBBS. One day, someone told her about PEF and from then on her financial hardships were resolved.

She applied for a scholarship and PEF granted it to her. Kainat graduated last year and is currently working in a private hospital in Rawalpindi and is currently working day and night treating patients of coronavirus and says that she will specialize further, she also wishes to open her own clinic in an underprivileged society.

Being An Inspiration For Others



Everyone says that Karachi is the city of opportunities. However, how could it be possible for Shoaib's family when his father had to feed nine family members with only PKR 25,000 per month? It was difficult for the family to meet the daily expenses while paying for the education of the children.

Shoaib had four more brothers and despite the shortage of money, they were still a very happy family, as they had learnt to make the best out of their limited means. Shoaib got a job in his school as a janitor, which he was grateful for as it ensured the family would have a little more cash. His school had a morning and an afternoon shift. Shoaib would attend the morning shift and would work as a janitor in the evening shift.

As a student and as a hardworking man, he was fascinated with computers. After his work was done, he would go to the computer lab and see how the other students were working on the computer. Shoaib knew that if he wanted to study further, it would be in the field of IT and Computer Sciences. He gave all he had to his studies and ended up with an A grade in his Matric and Inter exams. With this result, he went to a reputable technical university and applied over there.

The university was impressed by Shoaib's results and sent his information to PEF. Today, Shoaib has graduated with a BS in Computer Sciences and has been offered jobs from multiple software houses. He is an inspiration amongst his family and peers.

The Girl Who Dared To Dream



Who could have ever thought that a farmer's daughter would dream so big? Well, since no one can stop you from dreaming, a young girl in Sindh defied the norm of getting married at a young age and dared to do something big.

Bakhtawar always knew that she was different. In her class, where others would take hours to prepare for the exam, she would only take a couple of minutes to retain whatever she had studied.

She wasn't happy to see her father slaving away in the fields under the scorching sun. After finishing school Bakhtawar went up to her father and said that one day she will have her own garments business, where all the village women will be given jobs through which they would get a chance to change their lives.

The father, who had never dared to dream big for his own self, set aside years of fatigue and allowed his daughter to pursue her studies. Bakhtawar knew she wanted to make her father proud, so she worked hard and got 93% in matric and 91% in intermediate exams.

The family did not have enough funds to support her university education but as fate has it, one day one of her father's friends came back from Peshawar and told the family about PEF and how it helps underprivileged students. Bakhtawar immediately applied for a scholarship and got a positive response. Today, she in her final year and is one of the top students and her dream of starting a garment factory seems like it will be fulfilled.

A Step Closer To Becoming **An Engineer**



It was years back when Shahzeb lost his father, but to this day, his mother's crying face has been etched in his family. As if the emotional loss wasn't enough, Shahzeb's father was the sole bread earner for the family.

After he passed away, his pension, as a former teacher was barely enough to buy meals for the whole family of now five. The mother- a housewife did the best she could and gave her children the confidence and motivation that they would need to move ahead in life.

Shahzeb had a desire to be an engineer, as he wanted to contribute to the development of the country. His biggest strength was his perseverance and in all these years nothing could come in between him and his dream of becoming an engineer.

PEF always supported students with such resilience, so how could they ignore Shahzeb? With an outstanding intermediate result, Shahzeb didn't have to worry about his higher studies. Due to PEF's scholarship, he would be able to complete his civil engineering degree and fulfill his dream.

Today, Shahzeb is in his 3rd year and is a step closer to fulfilling his life long dream.

Faisal Wants To Change His Village



Faisal belonged to a small village where his father worked as a farmer for a landlord. His job sapped all his energy and yet left him with no money. In addition to the meagre pay, the landlord was harsh towards his farmers. Since there was so little income, Faisal went to a small madrassa in his early years where he acquired basic writing and reading skills.

One day, on a visit to a relative's house with his father in Khairpur, fate finally got a hold of him. His relative told Faisal's father how important it is to enroll him in a good school and persuaded him to leave Faisal with him.

Faisal was elated and worked hard in school and got excellent grades. Unfortunately, the distant relative met a very tragic accident and lost his life, and Faisal had to return to the lands with shattered dreams of pursuing higher studies.

It so happened, that a few research students from the Agriculture University were visiting the lands for their research project when they met Faisal. They suggested Faisal join their university and informed him about PEF's scholarship. Faisal grabbed the opportunity and today he is pursuing agriculture in Tandojam. His future plans are to apply his knowledge and skills with his father's experience to revolutionalise agriculture in his village.



What We Do

Professional Education builds a skilled and productive workforce, improve livelihoods, and develop sustainable communities.

The PEF mission is directly linked to develop young entrepreneurs and professionals that would help to increase economic activity across Pakistan. In Pakistan, we are a truly inclusive society, it requires sustained investments in educating the youth, especially those who belong to the marginalized communities. We want to equip them with professional skill sets to enable them, to become a part of the socio-economic landscape, and securing economic independence for themselves, as well as for their families.

PEF is currently funding the education costs of 1700 deserving students and provides hostel fees to a selected number of students.

At PEF, we give scholarships and financial assistance to the students on 'Need cum Merit' Base. A student, after getting admission on open merit can apply to the universities that are on our Board. We give scholarship fees directly to the university, so a student getting admission has to apply through the student affairs department of the respective university.

After ensuring merit and following a transparent selection process, PEF provides funds directly to the 37 public sector universities across Pakistan for professional education in the fields of Engineering, Medicine, Agriculture, Technology and Management.

PEF monitors the student's progress regularly and keeps in touch with them. It is committed to equal opportunity with no discrimination on the basis of religion, gender, caste, or creed.

Why Everyone Has Confidence In Us:

- Certified by Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy (PCP).
- Annual Audit by Haider Shamsi: Financial information and all records are available on the PEF website for review by any donor.
- People of integrity: Trustees, Board of Governors and Management are accomplished people of high repute.
- The Board Members and their immediate families funded 16 % of PEF expenses so far.
- The donations that we receive are not given to the students but directly disbursed to the university account.
- Our student selection process is very transparent, and we don't discriminate on any basis.
- We are zakat compliant and maintain a separate record for zakat and donations.
- We keep our donors regularly informed about our activities, donations and verifications.
- Donors who are sponsoring a student are kept informed about the progress of the student.

Fastest And Surest Return On Investment To Society:

- Professional Education is perhaps the quickest way of uplifting entire households above minimum poverty thresholds.
- Return on investment on professional education is excellent because the average academic annual cost of a student ranges around PKR 70,000/year and the total investment until graduation of an Engineer is PKR 280,000 and for a Doctor is PKR 350,000.
- Upon employment his /her first-year salary ranges between PKR 400,000 to PKR 600,000 which means that they will earn back the entire investment on their education in 8 months. This is just a start, and the life stories of our alumni show that as they grow in their careers, they will reach unimaginable heights.


The event concluded with fireworks in order to commemorate the fact that PEF completed 10 years of making their students' dreams come true.


PEF's Voice





PEF in USA has been raising funds for deserving students of Pakistan for 5 years. Last year, PEF raised funding for approximately 300 professional students. The donations in US are tax exempted and we are approved as 501 (c) nonprofit organization by the US Internal Revenue Service.

In order to spread our message across and create awareness PEF-US held two events in 2019-20.

- 1. Our Chairman Mr. Hafiz Haq was invited by Organization of Pakistani Entrepreneurs in Chicago (OPEN-Chicago) to their annual conference, where 250 prominent entrepreneurs and businessmen from the Pakistani diaspora joined. OPEN-Chicago wanted to show PEF as a successful & outstanding example of Social Entrepreneurship because it has lifted thousands of deserving students from poverty to respectability.
- 2. PEF and the Organization of Pakistani Entrepreneurs in **Houston** jointly arranged a symposium highlighting the important role Professional Education can play in alleviating poverty from Pakistan. It also showed how PEF's is directly contributing to the poverty alleviation project in Pakistan by changing the lives of thousands of deserving students. The event was held on 6th October 2019 at the prestigious location of Houston Museum of Natural Sciences. More than 125 people attended the event.






